Purpose and Methodology						
Purpose:	This data and survey are intended to inform Vermont voters of how candidates would vote if faced with proposals to restrict or repeal Vermont's medical-aid-in-dying law, also known as Act 39 and Death with Dignity.					
Column A:	In the 2016 legislative session, there was a proposal to repeal Act 39. For those candidates who were in the legislature at that time, this column shows Y for a vote to keep Act 39 in place and N for a vote to repeal.					
Column B:	This column reports the results of PCV's email survey to all candidates asking the question: "Are you inclined to oppose or support efforts to restrict or repeal Vermont's medical-aid-in-dying law (also known as "Act 39" and "Death with Dignity)?" "OPPOSE" answers are therefor from candidates who would vote to keep Act 39 in place, whereas "Support" answers are from candidates who would vote for restrictions or repeal.
